Reasons/purposes for processing information

We process personal information to enable us to provide a voluntary service for the benefit of the public in a particular geographical area as specified in our constitution; administer membership records; to fundraise and promote the interests of the charity; manage our employees and volunteers; maintain our own accounts and records.

Type/classes of information processed:

We process information relevant to the above reasons/purposes. This may include:

- 1. Personal details
- 2. Family detail
- 3. Lifestyle and social circumstances
- 4. Membership details
- 5. Goods and services
- 6. Financial details
- 7. Education and employment details

We also process sensitive classes of information that may include:

- 8. Physical or mental health details
- 9. Racial or ethnic origin
- 10. Religious or other beliefs of a similar nature



We process personal information about:

- 11. Members
- 12. Staff, volunteers
- 13. Trustees
- 14. Complainants
- 15. Supporters
- 16. Enquirers
- 17. Advisers and representatives of other organisations

Who the information may be shared with

We sometimes need to share the personal information we process with the individual themself and with other organisations. Where this is necessary, we are required to comply with all aspects of the Data Protection Act (DPA). What follows is a description of the types of organisations we may need to share some of the personal information we process with for one or more reasons.

Where necessary or required we share information with:

- 18. Members
- 19. Family, associates, or representatives of the person whose personal data we are processing.
- 20. Employees
- 21. Current, past, and prospective employers
- 22. Healthcare, social and welfare organisations
- 23. Educators and examining bodies.
- 24. Financial organisations
- 25. Employment and recruitment agencies
- 26. Survey or research organisations.
- 27. Business associates and professional advisers
- 28. Providers of goods and services
- 29. Local and central government
- 30. Other voluntary and charitable organisations
